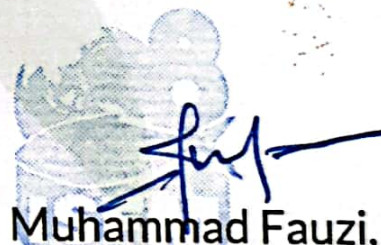

Preface

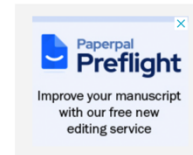
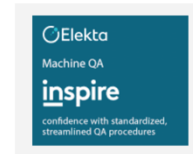
